COMP AND WIT CAME TO THE HQ AND GAVE WRITTEN AFFIDAVITS REGARDING  
THIS OFFENSE. THE COMP AND WITNESS BOTH STATED THAT THEY STARTED THE  
EVENING AT A COCKTAIL PARTY THAT WAS AT THE ASIAN ART MUSEUM. THE COMP  
HAD 5 DRINKS AND THE WIT HAD 3 DRINKS; THEY THEN WENT TO DINNER WHERE  
EACH OF THEM HAD AN ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE. (COMP SAID HE DRANK A SODA;  
STATES THAT THE COMP DRANK A BEER). AFTER DINNER THE COMP AND WIT THEN  
PROCEEDED TO JR'S WHERE THE COMP HAD 2 BEERS AND THEN PROCEEDED TO THE  
ROUNDUP AND CONSUMED 2 MORE BEERS. THE COMP AND WIT THEN WENT BACK TO  
THE HOTEL AND CONSUMED ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC DRINK. AT THIS TIME WIT  
WENT TO THE BATHROOM AND COMP MADE A COMMENT THAT WIT WAS GOOD  
LOOKING. ANOTHER PERSON THAT WAS AT THE TABLE WITH COMP AND WIT MADE  
CAT CALLS AND SEXUAL GESTURES AS WIT PASSED BACK BY WHEN RETURNING  
FROM THE RESTROOM. WIT STATED THAT THE COMP'S PARTY CONTINUED TO  
STARE AT HIM AND MAKE HIM FEEL UNCOMFORTABLE. WIT ; WHO WAS IN  
TOWN FOR A CONFERENCE; TOLD HIS SUPERIOR-SUSP ABOUT THIS. SUSP  
APPROACHED THE COMP AND ASKED THE COMP AND HIS FRIENDS TO STOP. A SMALL  
VERBAL ARGUMENT EVOLVED AND COMP STOOD UP FROM HIS CHAIR. SUSP AT THIS  
TIME FELT THREATENED AND SHOVED THE COMPLAINANT BACK DOWN INTO HIS CHAIR  
THE COMP FELL FORWARD AND HIS FACE HIT THE GLASS TUMBLER;CAUSING A SMALL  
CUT ON THE BRIDGE OF THE COMP'S NOSE. COMP DID SEEK MEDICAL ATTENTION  
TODAY. THE XRAYS DID NOT SHOW A BROKEN NOSE AND THE COMP WAS TOLD THAT  
THEY WERE NOT ABLE TO READ THE X-RAYS. THE COMP BROUGHT THE DOCUMENTS  
FROM THE CLINIC TO THE HEADQUARTERS. THE SUSP AND WIT WERE AT THE  
HEADQUARTERS WHEN THE COMP CAME BY. THE COMP STATED THAT HE DID NOT  
WISH TO COME BACK TO DALLAS TO PURSUE THE CHARGES. THE COMP AND SUSP  
TALKED, THE SUSP APOLOGIZED TO THE COMP AND WIT FOR HIS ACTIONS.  
BOTH PARTIES DISCUSSED THAT BOTH OF THEM WERE INTOXICATED AND THAT EACH  
HAD A PART IN THIS EVENT. THIS IS NOT A HATE CRIME AS THE SUSPECT DID  
NOT SINGLE OUT THE COMP FOR HIS SEXUAL ORIENTATION. DURING THE HEAT  
OF THE ALTERCATION THE SUSP DID CALL THE COMPLAINANT A FAGGOT.  
THE COMPLAINANT STATED THAT HE DID NOT HAVE TIME TO COME BACK TO DALLAS  
TO PURSUE THIS OFFENSE AND WAS GLAD THAT THE SUSPECT APOLOGIZED AND  
RECOGNIZED THAT HIS ACTIONS WERE WRONG.  
THE COMPLAINANT SIGNED AND AFFIDAVIT OF NON-PROSECUTION ON THIS DATE.  
SGT. SUNDQUIST SENT A MEMO TO THE MUNICIPAL PROSECUTOR TO VOID CITATION  
C19-062024.
