

Cedar Springs Pedestrian Safety Improvements

Short- Term

1	Install yellow warning flashers - at Knight Street (one for northbound and one for southbound traffic) - at Reagan Street (one for northbound and one for southbound traffic) - first 30 days flashers will be active 24/7 - after 30 days flashers will be push button activated (additional equipment required)	January 25th
2	Install painted crosswalks at Knight Street (in front of Library)	January 18th
3	Install "NO PEDESTRIAN" crossing signs in front of Kroger/ Ilume	January 18th
4	Enhance sidewalk in front of the Round Up Saloon - raises striped area six inches with curbs (currently at same grade as street) - paint yeild bars in advance of the crosswalks to distance vehicles from pedestrians in the crosswalk	February 1st
5	Educate pedestrians to cross at marked crosswalks - work with community to circulate flyers following installation of flashers and crosswalks	Begin January 25th
6	Increase Police enforcement	In Progress
7	Install additional street lights (illumination)	Completed

Mid-Term

8	Install traffic signal at Knight (funded) - Install ADA ramps as part of traffic signal installation	June 2012
9	Conduct Engineering Study at Cedar Springs and Reagan to determine if a traffic signal is warranted	February 1st
10	Remove right turn lane and island on southeast corner of Douglas and Cedar Springs (same corner as Kroger)	June 2012
11	Look for opportunities to install trees or other vegetation to calm traffic	TBD

Long-Term

12	Review area for "Complete Street" design - Look for opportunities to revise street width, lane configurations, landscaping, etc.	TBD
13	Contrasting crosswalk markings - Increases visibility of crosswalks and creates look of entertainment district+C15	TBD
