

Alameel addresses Stonewall as LGBT equality advocate

Democratic U.S. Senate candidate David Alameel attended the Stonewall Democrats of Dallas meeting Tuesday, the first time he has had contact with the state's largest Democratic organization. He faces Kesha Rodgers in a runoff. The Texas Democratic Party has issued a warning against Rodgers whose main platform is impeaching President Obama.

While Stonewall usually packs the back room at Ojeda's on Maple Avenue, attendance was sparse because gubernatorial candidate Wendy Davis was opening her Dallas headquarters on MLK Boulevard at the same time.

Alameel addressed not yet having visited the group. He said he's tried to visit each of the 254 counties in Texas, but when he arrives he mostly hears complaints that he hadn't been there yet.

He said he and his wife could retire to Hawaii and not have to work another day, but he said he remembers working minimum wage jobs. He wants to go to Washington, he said, to address the Republican war on women, war on the poor, war on the elderly and war on immigrants.

Alameel is an immigrant, himself. He was born in Haifa, Israel, and is Lebanese Christian. He's lived in the U.S. more than 40 years.

He attacked Texas Sen. John Cornyn for voting against protecting women in the military from sexual assault. He said he opposed corporate greed that shipped jobs overseas and recent Supreme Court decisions giving corporations the same rights as people.

"I don't remember where it said in the Bible God created Wall Street in His image," Alameel said.

He also attacked what he called the Republican war on the gay and lesbian community.

"I'm a devout Christian who accepts equality," he said.

He said if one of his kids told him he was gay, he knows how he'd want his child treated.

Early voting ends Friday, May 23. 7 a.m.–7 p.m. Runoff day is Tuesday, May 27. — David Taffet

Same-sex marriage battle spreads to the great state of Montana

Montana on Wednesday joined 28 other states with legal battles over gay marriage, while same-sex couples in Pennsylvania spent their first full day applying for marriage licenses knowing the governor wouldn't stand in their way.

The Associated Press reported that a federal lawsuit filed by four gay couples in Montana leaves just two states — North Dakota and South Dakota with gay marriage bans and no legal challenges

aiming to overturn them. But that's likely to change as same-sex marriage advocates there gear up for a legal fight.

State marriage bans have been falling around the country since the U.S. Supreme Court last year struck down part of the federal Defense of Marriage Act.

Gay and lesbian couples can wed in 19 states and the District of Columbia, with Oregon and Pennsylvania becoming the latest to join the list this week when federal judges struck down their bans and officials decided not to appeal.

The Montana couples say their state's constitutional ban denies gay couples the freedom and dignity afforded to other Montanans and robs them of the legal protections and benefits that come with marriage. Democratic Gov. Steve Bullock released a statement supporting their cause, while the state's Republican attorney general said he would vigorously defend the ban.

Meanwhile, a lesbian couple from Rapid City, S.D., said they also plan to challenge their state's constitutional ban on same-sex marriage in the coming days, along with a provision in federal law that lets states avoid recognizing gay marriages performed elsewhere. Their attorney said he's contemplating filing a lawsuit in North Dakota, too.

Here's a look at where things stand with other legal challenges across the country:

Arkansas

A state judge in Arkansas' largest county earlier this month struck down the state's gay marriage ban, saying the state has "no rational reason" for preventing gay couples from marrying. The state Supreme Court brought the marriages to a halt and is weighing state officials' appeal.

ldaho

State officials announced this week they will appeal last week's decision from a federal judge overturning the state's same-sex marriage ban. The appeal goes to the 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals which agreed to an expedited hearing.

Indiana

State attorneys have asked the 7th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Chicago to review a federal judge's recent order requiring Indiana to recognize the out-of-state marriage of a lesbian couple in which one woman is terminally ill. That ruling applies just to one couple — not to others who were legally wed elsewhere and are seeking to have Indiana recognize their marriages.

Kentucky

After a federal judge ordered Kentucky to recognize same-sex marriages performed in other states, attorney general Jack Conway said he would not defend the state's law. But, the state has hired outside attorneys to handle the case and is appealing to the 6th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in Cincinnati, which has not yet scheduled a hearing.

Michigan

The 6th Circuit is reviewing Michigan's same-sex marriage ban that was overturned by a federal judge in March following a rare trial that mostly focused on the impact of same-sex parenting on children. Arguments have not been scheduled.

Nevada

Eight gay couples are challenging Nevada's voter-approved 2002 ban that was upheld by a federal judge in 2012. The 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals in San Francisco hasn't scheduled arguments yet. Nevada Attorney General Catherine Cortez Masto is refusing to defend the ban.

Since 2011, GLBT LEAP has granted nearly \$20,000 in scholarships to deserving Texas students. Applicants are evaluated on demonstrated financial need, academic achievement and involvement in community service.

Preference is given to students who self-identify as gay, lesbian, bisexual or transgender, are members of LGBT families or are allies who have been strongly supportive of the LGBT community.

The GLBT LEAP scholarships are designed to build leadership and promote diversity in the LBGT and allied communities. Awards may be used for any post-secondary education, including nontraditional or alternative programs and vocational training.

"I am extremely grateful to the GLBT Leadership Education & Advocacy Program for selecting me to be a GLBT LEAP Scholar in 2011," said Pamela Bowers, Ph.D. "Because of the support I received from GLBT LEAP I was able to complete my education and begin giving back to the community."
